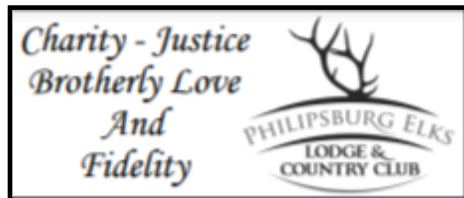
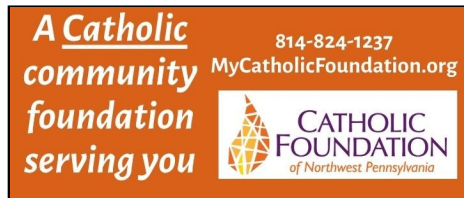

Parish Council Election: There is an open seat on the Parish Council. Jim Orichosky has resigned his seat on the council. We thank him for his service. The election will take place the weekend of March 22/23. To be nominated for the ballot, you must have a nomination petition signed by 5 parishioners who are non-family members. The petition forms can be found near the entrance to the churches, and must be turned in to the parish office by the weekend of February 22/23. We will only move to election if we have more than one person nominated for the petition. The person selected will fill out the remainder of this term, ending Sept. 1, 2026.

JJ Powell offers a Church Association Program in which they return 3 cents per gallon of fuel purchased by church members to the parish. All you need to do is call JJ Powell and tell them you want to participate for St. Agnes and they will note it on your account. Child Protection: Digital Dating Abuse can be defined as "a pattern of behaviors that control, pressure or threaten a dating partner using a cell phone or the internet." 1/4 of youth (12-17) who have been in a romantic relationship during the previous year report that they'd been the victim of digital dating abuse.
