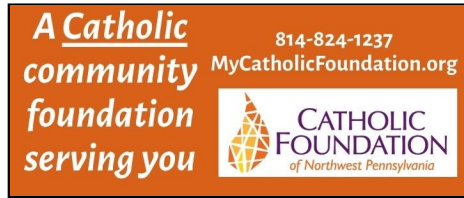

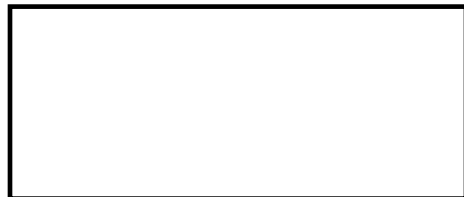

**HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION;** Monday, Dec. 9th is the solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation. The Holy Day Mass schedule is as follows; Sunday, Dec 8th @ 5:30pm St. Mary; Monday, Dec. 9th @ 8:30am St. Severin; Monday, Dec. 9th @ 5:30pm St. Agnes. You cannot do both the Sunday obligation and the Holy Day obligation by going to Mass on the 8th. It is not 2 for 1. Our calendars do not say this is a Holy Day, but the US Bishops were just informed by the Vatican a few weeks ago that it should be a Holy Day even if it falls on a Monday, so it is. We will run a normal weekend Mass schedule on Dec 7/8. Fr. Bill
