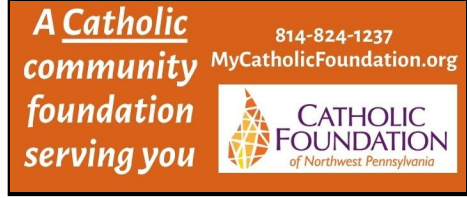

Bishop Persico has appointed Fr. William Barron as Sacramental Assistant to the following parishes in Mercer County: Beloved Disciple, Grove City/Good Shepherd, West Middlesex/Immaculate Heart of Mary, Mercer/Notre Dame, Hermitage/Our Lady of Fatima, Farrell/St Bartholomew, Sharpsville/St Columbkille, Stoneboro/St Michael, Greenville.

In this assignment he will support the pastors of the area by helping to provide sacramental assistance & other priestly ministry as needed. This role is intended to strengthen the ministry of the local church by ensuring that priests have support when they are ill, away or in need of assistance. Child Protection & Creating Safe Environments-Child Abuse Prevention Month: Report Child Abuse : It is every adult's moral responsibility to report known or suspected abuse or neglect of a minor to the responsible authorities. Physical and sexual abuse of minors are pervasive societal problems, and only concerted & sustained efforts by all adults in every segment of society can help to protect children and youth. According to the latest Pennsylvania statewide report in 2024 there were 5,214 substantiated reports of child abuse. 1,693 or 32.5% of the substantiated reports were for sexual abuse and 1,410 substantiated reports were physical abuse. 61.4% of child abuse victims were female. Mother and Father remain the person most responsible for abuse of their children. *To report child abuse, call Childline at 800-932-0323 (anytime 24/7)* For questions on reporting abuse in the Diocese of Erie, you may call the Office for the Protection of Children & Youth at 814-824-1195.
