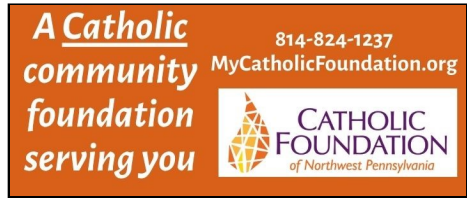

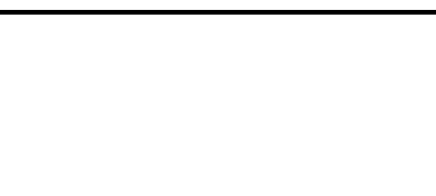

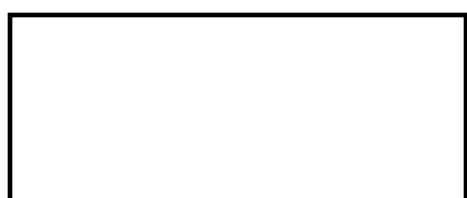

ServePro Happy Valley has begun the work of cleaning the fire damage at St. Agnes Social Hall kitchen. It is probably still weeks or a few months until we have a functional kitchen, but it is good to see progress. The hold up has been the insurance claims process. The third party administrator that administers the Diocese of Erie's self-insurance policy has been very unreasonable, unprofessional, and unresponsive. I am continuing to work to ensure that St. Agnes kitchen is fully restored and that it will be paid for by an insurance check, not out of pocket. That will be the end result. Fr. Bill Barron
