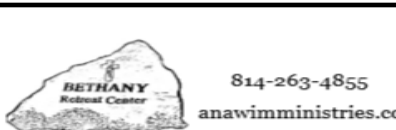

To receive the indulgence, you must receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday or a week before or after the date-you must have received Absolution in Confession 20 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday 9our penance service was within 20 days!), participate in Divine Mercy prayers in a church (either coming to our devotions, coming to mass, or doing something privately would be sufficient). You need to pray for the Pope & his intentions. Also, you need to be in a state of grace to receive any indulgence at all. Child Abuse Prevention Month-Throughout the Gospel, Christ calls upon His followers to care for the most vulnerable among us, especially children. Mandated Reporters in the Diocese of Erie are people who hold positions of trust in our schools, parishes, agencies, and institutions and are mandated by Pennsylvania Law and the diocesan Policy for Protection of Children to report suspected abuse of a minor. All employees and volunteers working/serving for the Diocese of Erie, in our parishes, schools or agencies are mandated reporters both legally and morally obligated to report any reasonable suspected or known child abuse to ChildLine, the local police or other appropriate agency.
